Mobiliseringsprosjekter på Svalbard

1,3 millioner kroner per år i tre år er øremerket Svalbard.

Longyearbyen Lokalstyre kan søke om prosjekt for virkemidler for kunnskapsbasert næringsutvikling.

Formålet er å bidra til økt verdiskaping og konkurransekraft i næringslivet, ved å mobilisere flere bedrifter til økt bruk av forskning i innovasjonsarbeidet sitt.

Næringsutviklingen må skje innenfor de rammene som ligger i miljømål og miljøregelverk for Svalbard.

Mobiliseringsprosjekter på fastlandet

11 fylker inkludert Oslo kommune kan søke om midler til regionale satsninger for mobilisering til økt verdiskaping i næringslivet.

Rammen på 51 millioner kroner er fordelt slik, med en øvre ramme for hvert fylke, og tildeles etter en kvalitetsvurdering av søknadene:

- Viken: 8 millioner
- Oslo: 3,5 millioner
- Innlandet: 5 millioner
- Vestfold og Telemark: 4 millioner
- Agder: 4 millioner
- Rogaland: 3,5 millioner
- Vestland: 6 millioner
- Møre og Romsdal: 3,5 millioner
- Trøndelag: 5 millioner
- Nordland: 3,5 millioner

- Troms og Finnmark: 5 millioner

Det er lagt inn en nedre ramme på 3 millioner kroner som vil tildeles hvert fylke ved akseptabel prosjektkvalitet.

Selv om tildelingen vil gjelde kun for 2021 for fylkene (ett år), kan prosjektbeskrivelsen vise til mer langsiktighet der det er hensiktsmessig.

Assessment criteria

Grant applications will be assessed in relation to the following criteria:

Excellence

Originality/Novelty

- The extent to which the concept is sound, credible and novel.

Solidity

- The extent to which the project objectives are clear and relevant.
- The quality of the proposed deliverables from the project.

Impact

Potential

- The extent to which the expected effects are specified.
- The extent to which expected impacts on the system and societal levels are specified.

Knowledge sharing and exploitation

- The quality of the proposed communication and dissemination activities.
- The extent to which it is credible that the proposed outputs will contribute to the specified effects and impact.

Implementation

Project Manager and project group

- The extent to which the Project Manager and project group are qualified and have the necessary expertise and are positioned to implement the project.
- The extent to which management structures and procedures are appropriate.

Plans and management

- The extent to which the work plan is clear and understandable, and the time table realistic
- The extent to which objectives and measures are coherent.
- The extent to which the project has the support of the leadership of the Project Owner and any partners, and the allocation of roles in the project is clear.
- The extent to which the budget is realistic and appropriate, and resources are allocated so that each of the partners can fulfil their role.

- The extent to which potential risks have been discussed.

Relevance to the call for proposals

The extent to which the project satisfies the guidelines and stipulations set out in the call for proposals.
